Hello to all our Parents and Bonshaw Community,

The cooler weather has arrived and winter is almost here. The students are wearing their new school shirts with pride and they look great. We also have school jackets available to buy with the new logo on them.

Our Small Schools Cross Country at Boggabilla was an opportunity for our students to show their perseverance and determination. We were excited to see them challenge themselves and keep going when the going got tough. We are learning new skills with our Athletics practice, as some of our students haven't had the opportunity to participate in these events before.

As part of our One School Small School cluster we are learning about Heat, Light and Sound in Science this term. An outing to Yetman Public School this week involved 5 of our One School cluster schools to join together for a STEM/Science day. The Year 3 to 6 students had an educator from STEM Punks who taught the students about the effects that artificial light has upon living things and the community. They then created a light censor using the microbit simulator. The K to Year 2 students were very engaged in a design and construction task where they designed either a robot or vehicle that uses lights and then constructed it out of cardboard. It was a great day out for both staff and students. A big thank you to Yetman Public School for hosting us all

As part of our school plan, one of our improvement measures is to have more than 70% of our students' attendance at school for more than 90% of the time within the next year. This week we had 80% of our students attend 100% of the week. Thank you to our parents who do keep us informed of what's happening and well done for this improved outcome.

It is so beneficial to each child's learning and development of life skills: remember that every day counts! To put it in perspective, if a student misses as little as 8 days in a school term, by the end of primary school they'll have missed over a year of school. Positive school attendance is a shared responsibility, and we as a school community are here to support each of our families with making every day count.


Winter School Music Program

Parents and Careres are reminded of the following advice from the department;

In accordance with <u>advice from NSW HealthExternal link</u>, parents and carers are reminded **NOT** to send children to school if they are unwell, even if they have the mildest flu-like symptoms.

NSW Health has requested that schools encourage anyone who is unwell or has even mild flu-like symptoms, to arrange to be tested through their local medical practitioner or one of the COVID-19 clinicsExternal link.

Students and staff with flu-like symptoms need to be tested and provide a copy of a negative COVID-19 test result and be symptom-free before being permitted to return to school.

Students who do not undertake a COVID-19 test will not be permitted to return to school for a 10-day period. Additionally, they must be symptom-free for at least 3 days prior to returning to school.
